- Recipes must feature a U.P. Cultivated Ingredient (Local produce or fish, wild game, honey, etc.)
- Two entries per person, one per category
- Entry Form, must be submitted by August 1, 2024.
 Submit printed form to info@upstatefair.org or mail to UP State Fair- Ladies Day, 1001 N Lincoln Road, Escanaba MI 49829. Online form also available at upstatefair.net.
- Include a sentence about your recipe, who created the recipe and when, and why you like to prepare it.
- Entries may be brought in any type of container (preferably disposable); it is not the responsibility of the fair to return any dishes.
- Entries must be named and be prepared at home and brought to the fair on the day and time of the contest.

Judging:

• Entries will be judged and winner will be announced during the Ladies Day pro-gram.
